



## Video Practical Examination Resubmission Policy

Candidates who have unsuccessfully completed the Video Practical Examination (VPE) portion of the certification examination and have received a letter from the certification team indicating specific deficiencies in their practical examination performance may resubmit additional VPE performance videos. A new video authorization and consent form should be submitted if a different model or patient is used in the resubmission. The resubmitted video will relate in its entirety only to the candidate's performance with respect to each unsuccessful task identified in the deficiency letter. Upon receipt of a candidate's resubmission request, the new videos will be reviewed by a different set of VPE evaluators, in order to assess candidate performance of the identified tasks, consistent with applicable BOC policies.

Candidates may resubmit VPEs concerning the following certifications:

- Orthotist, BOC-Certified (BOCO®), and
- Prosthetist, BOC-Certified (BOCP®).

Candidates who wish to resubmit a VPE must submit an original video, and three (3) copies, within sixty (60) days of the mailing date of the VPE deficiency letter issued by the certification team. The videos should contain only complete demonstrations of those tasks scored "U" in the deficiency letter. Candidates have four (4) opportunities to resubmit unsuccessful VPE videos, but must complete all required portions of the certification examination within three (3) years of the date of BOC candidate acceptance. If, after four (4) video resubmissions, BOC determines that the candidate's VPE performance of the identified deficient tasks is below the applicable certification standards, the candidate must submit an entirely new VPE, including the VPE administrative fee.

A candidate may request an extension of the time in which to resubmit an unsuccessful VPE video. This request, indicating the specific reason for the extension request, must be in writing, signed by the candidate, and received by the BOC at least ten (10) days prior to the resubmission deadline.

In the event a candidate fails to resubmit a VPE video within sixty (60) days of the resubmission period, or fails to request a resubmission extension request at least ten (10) days prior to the resubmission deadline, a late fee of \$25 will be assessed every two (2) months until the new video submission is received.
